



Adult Winter Basketball Leagues Frequently Asked Questions

Preseason

Question: When does registration take place?

Registration is October 24 – November 13, 2018

If you are registering in person:

You must have a **minimum of 7** player contracts to register and all fees are due at registration.

In-person Registration (anyone may enroll the team) occurs @ the MSCR Office, 3802 Regent St. 53705

Note: During In-Person Registration, an MSCR staff member will need to enter your team into the online registration system. Please make sure you have a valid email address and to give yourself enough time to wait for a staff member to process your registration.

Question: What do I need to do to prepare to register my team?

To register your team using the on-line system:

Go To: www.msccsportsleagues.org

Team Managers Need:

1. An email address to Create Account/Login
2. Team Name/Manager Information
3. Co-Manager Name, Email address, phone number
4. Email addresses of all players on roster (**Very Important!** This helps us communicate any changes and relay important information in a timely manner.)

On-Line Registration Instructions:

- Click "Register Here" tab at the top of the page.
- Create an account by registering your email address as a new user OR use your existing account.
- Enroll your team on desired night/location.
- Invite players to join your team roster online. System sends a link to your teammates to register!
- If your team is working with a sponsor contact 608-204-3024 to make alternate payment arrangements for your team. Sponsors may pay any portion of the player fees.

The invite serves as an "electronic" player card . . . after the team manager enrolls the team, an invitation link is sent to each player on the team via their personal e-mail account (provided by the team manager).

Players enroll (or join the team) by accepting the invitation, & enrolling (electronic player card). Players must pay their individual player fee on-line at the time of registration. Alternatively, players may submit a paper player card and cash/check.

Please Note: Teams that register online are not considered registered for the program until a **minimum of 7 players have enrolled for the team**. Enrolled means – players have accepted the invitation (created an account) and enrolled (electronic player card, complete with waiver) and paid the appropriate player fee.

To register your team in-person: (at the MSCR Office, 3802 Regent St. 53705)

- You must have a minimum of 7 signed player contracts and all fees are due at the time of registration. (player contract cards are obtained from MSCR or available on www.mscc.org)



Question: What are the fees involved to register a team?

- Team fee – There are no team fees.
- Residential player (MMSD resident) = \$65
- Non-residential player = \$75

*A resident is defined as someone who resides within the boundaries of the Madison Metropolitan School District.

Question: I am new to the area and would like to join a team. Do you know of teams that are in need of players?

- Teams in the MSCR program are formed by individuals, not by MSCR. However, we compile a “Free Agent” list of players looking to join a team and will make the list available to managers who are looking to add players to their team.
- To be placed on the Free Agent list go to our website at www.msportsleagues.org. Select “Free Agent sign up”. Submit the form and your name will be added to our player pool. Please fill out the form completely.
- There is no fee involved until you join a team.
- **MSCR cannot guarantee that you will be placed on a team.**

Question: Who are the leagues for?

- Leagues are for men and women ages 18 and older, who are no longer in High School.
- Teams must have a minimum of 7 players to register.
- A maximum of 50% of your roster may be nonresidents of the Madison Metropolitan School District.

Question: How do I know if I am a resident?

- To verify you are a MMSD resident, type in your address on the following website page: <https://accessdane.countyofdane.com/>.

Question: I would like to reserve a court for practice. How do I do this?

- MSCR does not issue practice permits for Basketball.
- Contact the Facilities Rental department of MMSD. Please visit <https://www.madison.k12.wi.us/facility-rentals> or call 442-1346 for more information (Please note: rentals are not done by phone. You must submit a formal request online.)

Question: When will schedules be available for teams?

- Schedules will be posted at www.msportsleagues.org in mid-December. Please share the website with your players.

Question: Can I play on more than one team?

- Yes. Individuals may play on multiple teams as long as they only play on one team per night. Players must have a player contract signed and pay the player fee for each team they play on. A player cannot sub on Team A, even for one game, without a contract and paying the fees for Team A, even though they have a contract for Team B.

Question: Do we need team uniforms? Jersey Information

- NEW FOR 2018: Individuals may purchase a jersey at \$20 each at the time of registration. Players are responsible for requesting the appropriate size and number. Refunds are not given for ordered jerseys.
- Yes, MSCR requires teams to have 2 sets of numbered jerseys or shirts (Reversible is OK). One light set and one dark set (jersey color should be as uniform as possible for all team members). Numbers must be permanently adhered, not taped on. Numbers can be on BOTH the front and



back of the jerseys OR if only on one side, the back is preferred. Legal numbers may not contain a 6, 7, 8 or 9.

Otherwise please wear appropriate shorts/pant and gym shoes. Jewelry must be removed or taped.

Question: Where are games played?

Most, but not all games are played at local High Schools. All locations for play are listed, High Schools are highlighted.

- **Allis:** 4201 Buckeye Rd., off Jerome St. Go through gate at end of lot. Enter double doors to the gym
- **East High School:** 2222 E. Washington Ave. Large lot off 4th St. Go up steps between fieldhouse & school – enter door #4
 - **Spec Gym B & G:** Enter door #4 and go up steps on your left; Spec Gym is on the right
 - **Fieldhouse** – Enter door #4, go up steps on left, follow entire length of hall in front of trophy case to the new.
- **Hamilton:** Enter off Segoe Rd. between Marathon Dr. and Richard Ln. to rear lot on east side of school. Use double glass doors. Gym is on the left.
- **LaFollette High School:** 702 Pflaum Rd
 - **Spec. Gym B & G:** enter door #10 (follow sidewalk to right – from the disabled parking spots). Go down hall, turn right; gym is on left
 - **Fieldhouse #1 – 4:** Park in north end of large lot near the practice fields & tennis courts. Enter glass doors, labeled #8 . Gyms are on the right
- **Memorial High School:** 201 S. Gammon Rd. Lot off Gammon Rd. between Memorial & Jefferson schools. Enter glass doors. Go halfway down the hall. Turn left. Courts #1 – 4 are on the left.
- **Sherman:** 1601 N. Sherman Ave. Lot off Ruskin St. Enter doors next to the lot, go down hall; gym is to the left
- **Toki :** 5606 Russett Rd. Lot off Whitney Way. Use 4-door glass entryway closest to playfield, take hallway to the right; gym is on the left.
- **West High School:** 30 Ash St. Park on Regent St. and side streets. Enter glass doors(3a or 3b) on Regent St. nearest Speedway Rd. Gym 2050: right, Gym 2051: center, Gym 2052: left

In-Season

Question: How long is the season?

- NEW in 2018, Winter Basketball will be a 7 week round robin plus a final alignment game.

Question: School was cancelled due to a snow day, are we playing tonight?

- No. On snow days all programs, functions, etc. held at schools are cancelled for the day.

Question: Our game has been postponed. What does this mean?

- If a game has been postponed it will be rescheduled at the end of the regular season on your regular night of play. Make-up schedules will be emailed to team managers and posted on-line at www.msqr.org and www.msqrsporsleagues.org.

Question: I lost an item at the game last night. What should I do?

- Please check back with the MSCR Site Supervisor where you played your last game as found items are kept locked in a storage area.(Please note, you do not have to go on your night of play,



but check the online schedule first to make sure MSCR has Adult Basketball games going on that night).

- If your item is not found, please contact 608-204-3024 to see if your item was turned in.

Question: Our score was reported wrong or it appears the standings are incorrect on the website. Who should we contact?

- Contact 204-3024 or asld@madison.k12.wi.us with your team name, league name, the night you play, and explain what you feel is incorrect. MSCR will respond to your concern in a timely fashion.

Question: How long do I have to add players to my team?

- You have until 4:30 p.m. on Thursday, February 1, 2018 to add players to your team. Fees for resident players are \$65 and fees for non-resident players are \$75.

Question: Am I able to have substitute players on my team?

- Yes! Managers may add up to two substitute players, at \$10 each, to the team as long as the minimum number of players has been met (7). Contact 608-204-3024 or asld@madison.k12.wi.us for assistance. Please provide the player's name, address, email address, phone number, and date of birth.
