### Expectations

MSCR is committed to providing a program free of harassment or discrimination of any kind.

## Pass the Word!

Managers are expected to relay all program and rule information to their teammates.

- ◆ If they are ejected from a game, they must also sit out the next two games?

## Rules and Equipment

**Personal Fouls (Rule Emphasis):** In a continuing effort to eliminate excessive contact, the following acts constitute a personal foul when committed against a ball handler/dribbler. A player becomes a ball handler when he/she receives the ball. This includes a player in a post position:

- ⇒ Placing two hands on the player
- ⇒ Placing an extended arm bar on the player
- ⇒ Placing and keeping a hand on the player
- ⇒ Contacting the player more than once with the same or alternating hands

### **Required Shirts/Jerseys:**


Each team must have BOTH a light and dark colored shirt. Each set must be uniform in color. All shirts must have permanently adhered numbers to the front and/or back.

### Phone Ahead

No one likes showing up to a game just to learn the opponent is not there.

If you know ahead of time that your team will forfeit, please call MSCR. We will call your opponent and staff.

## Jerseys!?!

MSCR requires each team to have a set of light and a set of dark jerseys with permanently adhered numbers.

**Each jersey MUST be all the same color.**

Professionally printed shirts/jerseys can be expensive. **MSCR does NOT require professional printing.** A set of store bought shirts numbered with permanent marker or fabric paint works just as well. **Taped on numbers are NOT allowed.**

If numbering only one side of your shirts/jerseys please number the back as it is easier for referees to see.

### Move it or Lose it

Parking at the High Schools can be tough before the 7:15 games

as parents are picking up students. Please allow 5 extra minutes to park and walk.

Do Not Park in Fire Lanes:

**\$50+ tickets are given by the City of Madison to vehicles parked in fire lanes!** You are coming for exercise, so consider the longer walk a good warm up!

### Winter Weather

Wisconsin winters can be very unpredictable. When road conditions are bad, make sure to allow yourself plenty of travel time. Teams must have a minimum of 4 players dressed and ready at game time or the team will forfeit.

Arriving a few minutes early will give you time to talk, stretch, and get changed, It is better than a forfeit or a snow-related accident.

In cases of extreme weather, games may be postponed. If MMSD has a snow day and schools are closed, all games will be postponed. If you are unsure if the game has been postponed, **please call the weather line at 204-3044 or check [mscr.org](http://mscr.org) or [mscrsportsleagues.org](http://mscrsportsleagues.org)** for the most up to date information.

### Keep it Clean

Please remember to keep the sidelines clear by putting your jackets, sweats, etc. in the locker room or on the sidelines near your team's bench. This will help everyone avoid injuries.

You may also bring a lock and use one of the lockers to store things such as phones and jewelry for the whole team. That way nobody forgets their valuables!

### Not So Fast

Players are not permitted into the gym until 10 minutes prior to the first scheduled game of the evening.

Only site supervisors & officials are permitted to enter early to set up equipment which makes a difference for starting games on time.

Teams using non-registered players will forfeit the game and may be dropped from the program.
