

# Winter Basketball FAQ



## **PRESEASON:**

### **Question: When does registration take place?**

Registration is open October 19 - November 11, 2022 (or until spots are filled)  
Late registration closes 12/2/22 and will incur an additional \$10 fee

You may register online at [www.msportsleagues.org](http://www.msportsleagues.org)

### **Question: What do I need to do to prepare to register my team?**

To register your team using the online system ([www.msportsleagues.org](http://www.msportsleagues.org)), you will need:

- An email address to create an account / login
- Team name, manager name, co-manager name and information
- First/last name and email address for each player that will be on the roster (Email address must be unique to each player)
- Jersey color for the team

#### Online Registration Instructions:

- Visit [msportsleagues.org](http://msportsleagues.org)
- Click "Register Here" at the top of the page
- Create an account by registering your email address as a new user or use your existing account
- Enroll your team on desired night / location by following screen prompts
- Complete the enrollment by "Checking out"
- Click on "Manage Rosters" in your account. Add players to your roster (must have first/last name and email address for each player) NOTE: The system will automatically send an email invitation to join your team to each player listed
- If your team is working with a sponsor, contact 608-204-3024 to make alternate payment arrangements for your team. Sponsors may pay any portion of the fees.
- Fee assistance is available to MMSD residents. Contact us directly at [asld@madison.k12.wi.us](mailto:asld@madison.k12.wi.us) or 608-204-3024 to request the form.

#### Player registration

- An email invitation (with embedded link for enrollment) will be emailed to each person listed on the team roster
- Click on the link in the invitation email. (This will take you to [msportsleagues.org](http://msportsleagues.org)) Login to your account using your email address.
- Add your roster enrollment to the cart, make appropriate payment
- NOTE: Jersey must be ordered and paid for at time of registration, no exceptions

### **Question: What are the fees to register a team?**

- Team fees: None
- Player fees: \$72 per MMSD resident / \$82 per non-resident
  - A MMSD resident is defined as anyone who lives in the Madison Metro School District
- Late registrations will incur an additional \$10 fee

**Question: I am new to the area and would like to join a team. Do you know of teams that are in need of more players?**

- Teams in the MSCR program are formed by individuals, not by MSCR.
- MSCR maintains a "Free Agent" list of players looking to join a team. The list is made available to managers in need of additional players.
- Visit [www.msportsleagues.org](http://www.msportsleagues.org) and select "Free Agent Sign Up". Submit the form to have your information added to the list.
- There is no fee until you join a team.
- MSCR cannot guarantee that you will be placed on a team

**Question: Who are the leagues for?**

- Leagues are for participants ages 18 and older, who are no longer in High School.

**Question: How do I know I am a MMSD resident?**

- To verify you are a MMSD resident, type your address on the following website page: <https://accessdane@countyofdane.com>. If you pay taxes to the City of Madison you are considered a MMSD resident.

**Question: I would like to reserve a court for practice. How do I do this?**

- MSCR does not issue practice permits.
- Contact the Facilities Rental Department of MMSD. Visit <https://www.madison.k12.wi.us/facility-rentals> for more information.

**Question: When will schedules be available for teams?**

- Schedules will be posted to [msportsleagues.org](http://msportsleagues.org) two weeks prior to the start of the season. Please share the website with your players.

**Question: Do we need team uniforms?**

- Yes, teams should have 2 sets of numbered jerseys or shirts (reversible is ok). Jersey color should be as uniform as possible for all players.
- Numbers must be permanently adhered to the back of the shirt/jersey. Legal numbers may not contain a 6, 7, 8 or 9.

**Question: Where are games played?**

- Most, but not all games, are played at local High Schools. All locations are listed.
  - **Allis:** 4201 Buckey Rd, off Jerome St. Go through gate at end of lot. Enter double doors to the gym.
  - **Hamilton:** Enter off Segoe Rd between Marathon Dr and Richard Ln to rear lot on east side of school. Use double glass doors. Gym is on the left.
  - **LaFollette High School:** 702 Pflaum Rd
    - Spectator Gym B & G: Enter door #10 (follow sidewalk to the right - from the disabled parking spots. Go down the hall, turn right, gym is on the left.
    - Fieldhouse #1-4: Park in north end of large lot near the practice fields & tennis courts. Enter glass doors (#8). Gyms are on the right.

### **Question: Where are games played (CONT.)**

- **Memorial High School:** 201 S Gammon Rd. Lot off Gammon Rd between Memorial & Jefferson schools. Enter glass doors. Go halfway down the hall. Turn left. Courts #1-4 are on the left.
- **Sherman:** 1601 N Sherman Ave. Lot off Ruskin St. Enter doors next to the lot, go down hall, gym is on the left.
- **Toki:** 5606 Russett Rd. Lot off Whitney Way. Use 4 door glass entryway closest to playfield, take hallway to the right. Gym is on the left.
- **West High School:** 30 Ash St. Park on Regent St and side streets. Enter glass doors (3a or 3b) on Regent St nearest Speedway Rd. Gym 2050: right, Gym 2051: center, Gym 2052: left

## **IN-SEASON:**

### **Question: How long is the season?**

- Winter Basketball will be a 7 week round robin plus a final alignment game (8 games total)

### **Question: School was cancelled due to a snowy day, are we playing tonight?**

- No. On snow days all program, functions, etc held at schools are cancelled for the day.
- Check the weather information at [www.mscl.org](http://www.mscl.org) by clicking on "Weather Related Information" at the top of the page

### **Question: I lost an item at the game last night. What should I do?**

- Please check back with the MSCR Site Supervisor where you last played
- Found items are kept in a storage area
- Check the MSCR Lost/Found website at [www.msclsportsleagues.org](http://www.msclsportsleagues.org)
- If your item was not found, contact 608-204-3024 to see if your item was turned in

### **Question: Our score was reported wrong or it appears the standings are incorrect on the website. Who should we contact?**

- Contact MSCR at [asld@madison.k12.wi.us](mailto:asld@madison.k12.wi.us) or 608-204-3024 with your team name, league name, night you play and explain what you feel is incorrect. MSCR will respond to your concern in a timely manner.

### **Question: How long do I have to add players to my team?**

- January 31, 2023 is the last day to add players.

### **Question: Am I able to have substitute players on my team?**

- Yes! Substitute players may be added for \$10 per substitute as long as the minimum number (7) of players has been enrolled / paid.
